- 4. Why does Elihu intervene? What is his perspective? Job 32-37
- 5. Who/what is Wisdom and her perspective? Job 28
- 6. What does the Lord have to say? Job 5, 38-41
- 7. What theological questions do Job and his friends ask that we still ask today?
- 8. How is the moral of the story of Job different from/alike/related to or not these questions?
